*Transliteration is written in International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA) both here and in the score. The transliteration is based off Armenian pronunciations used before the language reformation that followed World War I in order to more closely coincide with what Komitas would have heard.

About the Composer:

Komitas Vardapet is widely considered to be the godfather of Armenian Classical Music. Though born in the Ottoman Empire, he trained as a musician in Berlin. Following his studies, he extensively studied and documented the workings of Armenian folk music. The combination of having such a profound understanding of Armenian folk music and western training allowed him to create truly Armenian classical music.





About the Poet:

Hovhannes Tumanyan is widely considered the national poet of Armenia. His poetry is so simple, beautiful, and connected to the natural world that many Armenian adages and saying come from his work. In his public life, he had taken on the roles of a peacemaker, a revolutionary, and religious leader. He even founded the House of Armenian Art in Tiflis. From his poetry to his everyday life, Tumanyan lived the kind of life that any Armenian, or any person, could aspire to.

The Komitas Series:

Just as Komitas brought classical music to Armenia, *The Komitas Series* seeks to bring Armenian classical music to the world. As much of Armenia's classical music can often be difficult to find, translate, or transliterate for non-Armenian speakers, *The Komitas Series* provides performance editions of Armenian classical music literature that is more accessible and understandable for all.


